

**2014 – 2015 Pre-Season GPBOA Test
Answer Key**

1. A-1 has a side line throw-in in his/her back court. A-1 throws the ball and it hits Team B's back board. A-2 receives the ball, is this legal? **Yes-9.2.2 Situation A Case Book.**
2. A goal can be scored when the clock is stopped. **True-5-1.**
3. A-1 the thrower-in dribbles the ball on the floor on the out of bounds area before making the throw-in. Is this legal? **Yes- 9.2.2 Situation D Case Book.**
4. Thrower-In A-1 inadvertently steps onto the court in bounds. A-1 immediately steps back into normal out of bounds throw-in position. There was no defensive pressure. The trail official rules a throw-in violation. **True- 9.2.5 Situation A Case Book.**
5. A free throw shall be attempted from within the free throw semicircle and behind the free throw line. **True 1-5-1**
6. A-6 and B-6 leave the bench because a fight has broken out. A-6 and B-6 do not participate in the fight. Each Head Coach is indirectly charged with a technical foul? **True- 10-6- Penalty- 8-b-1.**
7. A-1's second free throw is in flight. The trail official inadvertently blows his/her whistle. A-1's try is unsuccessful. Handle the Situation? **Go to the A.P. Arrow.4-36-2c.**
8. If an official erroneously grants a time out request, allow the team the time out and charge it to them? **True- 2.4.4 A- General provisions.-Manual.**
9. Opponents may not be granted a time out once the ball is at the disposal of the free thrower. **True- 5-8-3a**
10. A-4 picks the ball up in the back court. The trail official 'no calls" the play? **True- 9-9-1**
11. An illegal number in the official score book is a direct technical foul charged to the Head Coach? **False- 3.4.3 Situation B Case Book {c}. The player must enter the game.**
12. Team A has a throw-in in their back court. There is 5:07 on the game clock and the game clock never starts when the ball is in bounded. The trail official has 5 seconds on his/her "10" second count. Handle the Situation? **The trail official will put 5:02 on the game clock. The trail official has definitive information. 5-10-1.**
13. The three second lane restriction is not in effect when Team A has control of the ball in their back court. **True- 9-7-1.**
14. B-1 is guarding dribbler A-1, B-1 is within 6 feet, B-2 switches with B-1 in guarding A-1 and does not break the continuity. The closely guarded count shall continue. **True-4-10.**
15. A free throw ends when the ball touches the floor. **True-4-20-3**
16. A player is officially disqualified and becomes bench personnel when an official notifies the player? **False-4-14-2.**

17. Team control ends when a try for field goal is in flight. **True-4-6.**
18. A-1 the airborne shooter is fouled by B-1 when A-1 returns to the floor on one foot. A-1 was not fouled in the act of shooting. **True- 5-1-14**
19. You can only score points when the clock is "running". **False- 5-1-15**
20. A-1 the thrower-In throws the ball through Team A's basket. This is a throw-in violation. **True- 9-5-1g**
21. On a tap, Continuous Motion starts when the tapper touches the ball in a normal tapping movement. **True-4-8**
22. The assistant coach may enter the court in the situation where a fight may break out or has broken out to prevent the situation from escalating. **False-10-4-5-Note**
23. Pivot foot restrictions and the traveling rule are in effect for a throw-in. **False-9-2-1 Situation A- Case Book-Comment**
24. A-1 is fouled on a rebound and then taps the ball into the basket. Cancel the goal and penalize the foul. **True- 4-11-1.**
25. A-1 is tapping the ball at Team A-s basket. The ball is in flight and A-3 pushes B-3. The basket should count if successful and the foul shall be penalized? **True- 6-7-7; 6-7-9-Exception a and b**
26. The next A.P throw-in should be Team B's. By mistake the ball is given to Team A. Thrower-In A-1 throws a pass to A-3 who pushes off. The trail official penalizes the foul and corrects the A.P. throw-in? **True- Case Book- 6.4.1 Situation D**
27. During a jump ball, A-1 intentionally fouls B-1. When is the A.P. Arrow set? **"A" The A.P Arrow is set when the ball is at the disposal of the thrower-in after the intentional personal foul. 4-3**
28. Who designates the shooter for a technical foul? **Head Coach or Team captain. 8-3**
29. All back court violations go to the division line away from the table? **False.7-5-2a**
30. A-1 is fouled by B-1 on a lay-up. The try lodges between the ring and the back board. A-1 is awarded "2" free throws? **True. 6.4.3 Situation B case Book**
31. A1 throws the ball over the head of B1 and takes several steps around B1, allows the ball to strike the floor and then dribbles the ball to the basket and scores. The officials rule this a legal play and good basket. Were the officials correct? **Yes Ruling Legal, good basket.**
- Comment:** If A1 would have caught the ball or even touched the ball before it touched the floor, it would have been a traveling violation.
32. A1 dives for a loose ball and slides after gaining control. A1 is in a position either on his/her back or stomach the officials rule this a traveling violation. Are the officials correct? **No Ruling: Legal, this is not traveling. 4-44-5b Situation C**

Comment: Once A1 has the ball and is no longer sliding, he/she may not roll over, may sit up if on his/her back, may pass, shoot, start a dribble or call time-out. He/she may not attempt to get up to his/her feet without starting a dribble first.

- 33.** A1 is dribbling when he/she drops to a position with a knee on the floor and then ends the dribble. The Official calls a traveling violation. Is the official correct? **No – Legal, it is not traveling 2-44**

Comment: It would have been traveling if A1 dropped to a knee while holding the ball because A1 touched the floor with something other than a hand or foot.

- 34.** Team A is in the bonus. A1 is fouled and erroneously awarded the ball out of bounds. Following the throw-in, B1 intercepts as pass, but fumbles the ball and A2 recovers it. The error is now recognized. The officials award A1 his/her one and one with no players occupying the free throw lane line spaces and resumes play at the point of interruption. Is the official correct? **No – There has been no change of possession, so adjudicate free throws at point of interruption and line all players up. 2-10-1a & 2-10-3**

- 35.** A1 receives a pass with both feet on the floor. A1 pivots, establishes his/her right foot as the pivot foot. A1 steps with the left foot, then lifts the right foot and passes the ball to A2. The official rules a traveling violation by A1. Is the official correct? **NO – legal play 4-44-1 & 4-44-3**

- 36.36.** During a time out, if the administering official needs to leave the throw-in spot, he/she may place the ball on the floor at the spot of the throw-in. **True- 2.4.C-3. page 40 NF Manual**

- 37.** The center official rules a travel on A-1, the lead official rules a foul on B-1 on A-1. The officials get together and rule that the travel occurred first? **True- 2-6**

- 37.** Trail or Center may facilitate a rotation, but only the lead initiates a rotation. *True Official's Manual pg. 135*

- 38.** Non-calling official(s) should assist with identify the shooter and assist the calling official. **True – Official's Manual pg. 149-150**

- 39.** Do not switch when a “non-shooting” foul is going to the opposite court. **True Official's Manual Pg 179**

- 40.** We do not switch on a foul in the front court if the calling official is on tableside. **True Official's Manual pg. 179**

- 41.** Officials should beckon substitutes when seeking entry. **True 2-7-7**

- 42.** When a red light behind the backboard or a LED light on the backboard is present, it is permitted to signal the expiration of time in the quarter/extra period. If no red/LED is present, the audible timer's signal will continue to signal the expiration of time. **True 1-14**

- 43.** Each official has responsibility for out-of-bound plays. Another official may provide additional information to assist to get the play right but does not have authority to overrule the calling

official. It's up to the calling official to digest the information and then decide to change the call or not. **True Official's Manual Pg. 118**

- 44.** A non-calling official shall inform the coach when a player is disqualified or when the head coach loses the right to use the coaching box **True**
- 46.** A-1 receives a pass and fumbles the ball. A-1 recovers the fumble and dribbles. This is a legal play. **True- 4-16-1 and 2**
- 47.** To have a kicking violation, the kick must be intentional. **True- 9-7-1**
- 48.** A-1 is dribbling the ball in his /her front court. B-1 and A-3 foul each other at the same time off the ball. Team A will receive the ball at the point of interruption. **True- 10-1-17- Penalty- f.**
- 49.** A-1 throws a pass to A-3. While the pass is in flight, the center official inadvertently blows his/her whistle. The game will continue with the AP Arrow. **False- 4-9-2b, 4-9-3, 4-20-1, 4-27-1 a-e**
- 50.** A dead ball contact technical foul is two shots and the ball at the division line on either side of the table. **True {Men}- 10-3-1;**
